WHEREAS, ORS 254.205 requires the County to select two newspapers of general circulation in the County to publish sample ballots, and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners has determined that the Register Guard and the Springfield News are the two newspapers of general circulation in the County which meet the requirements of ORS 254.205, and

WHEREAS, ORS 294.230 requires the County to select one daily or weekly newspaper of general circulation in the County to publish an annual statement of contracts in August, and

WHEREAS, ORS 311.615 requires the County to select a newspaper of general circulation in the County in which the tax collector shall publish to obtain service of personal property tax warrants, and

WHEREAS, ORS 312.040 requires the County to select a newspaper of general circulation in the County in which the tax collector shall publish to give notice of real property tax foreclosure proceedings, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that the Register Guard is the newspaper that meets the requirements of ORS 294.230, 311.615 and 312.040, now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Register Guard and the Springfield News are hereby selected for 1996 as the two newspapers in which the ballots shall be published so long as the newspapers comply with ORS 254.205, and it is further

ORDERED that the Register Guard is hereby selected for 1996 as the newspaper in which the annual statement of contracts shall be published pursuant to ORS 294.230, the personal property tax warrants shall be published pursuant to ORS 311.615, and the notices of real property tax foreclosure proceedings shall be published pursuant to ORS 312.040.
