WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners on October 3, 1995 did accept a Supportive Housing grant from U.S. Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, Catholic Community Services has been designated by HUD to provide housing scholarships to low income households involved with educational/self improvement programs, and

WHEREAS, Lane County Health & Human Services did not anticipate the increase in funds in Fund 85: and

WHEREAS, the increase in funds requires increasing appropriations in fund 85 for FY 95/96; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners as the governing body of Lane County may, in accordance with ORS 294.326.(2) appropriate by resolution unanticipated revenues and expenses; now therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED & ORDERED, that Lane County adjust the FY 95/96 budget for the Department of Health and Human Services by increasing the appropriation of revenues and expenditures in fund 85 in the amount of \$30,460; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign a subcontract with Catholic Community Services for a three year period in the amount of \$145,051.
