WHEREAS, The Department of Youth Services (DYS) has received a federal grant from the Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT); and

WHEREAS, DYS desires to enter into an Interdepartmental Agreement with, and transfer revenues to, the Health and Human Services Department (H&HS) to help it fulfill some of the CSAT grant requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services must use those revenues in fiscal year 1995-96 through its administrative agency, Lane County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing board of Lane County may, in accordance with Oregon Revised Statute 294.326(2), appropriate by resolution, unanticipated revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the agreement with DYS requires the establishment of a 1.0 FTE Mental Health Specialist (MHS) position within H&HS; now therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners increase the fiscal year 1995-96 budget for the Department of Health and Human Services by the increase in appropriations in Fund 86 of \$35,612 in revenues and expenditures; and it is further

ORDERED, that a 1.0 FTE Mental Health Specialist (MHS) position be established in the Department of Health and Human Services.
