(COUNTY-MAINTAINED ROAD SYSTEM**


**WHEREAS**, on January 17, 1996, the Board was presented with a staff report regarding an appeal to a Director of Public Works' decision to deny county-maintained road status to the non-county maintained portion of Lois Lane; and

**WHEREAS**, after consideration of the matter, the Board decided that Lois Lane was of benefit to the general public satisfying LM 15.220(3) and therefore the petitioner's appeal should be accepted; **NOW THEREFORE BE IT**

**ORDERED**, that the petitioner's appeal is accepted based upon the non-county maintained portion of Lois Lane being of benefit to the general public per LM 15.220(3) and that the petition for acceptance of a portion of Lois Lane into the county-maintained road system be accepted for further action pursuant to LM 15.250.
