WHEREAS, the City of Eugene has allocated \$40,000 for the purpose of assisting an agency with a budget shortfall; and

WHEREAS, Lane County Health and Human Services did not anticipate the increase in Fund 85; and


WHEREAS, the increase in funds requires increasing appropriations in Fund 85 for FY 95/96; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners as the governing body of Lane County may, in accordance with ORS 294.326.(2) appropriate by resolution unanticipated revenues and expenses; now therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that Lane County adjust the FY 95/96 budget for the Department of Health and Human Services by increasing the appropriation of revenues and expenditures in Fund 85 in the amount of \$40,000; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Eugene and a subsequent subcontract with St. Vincent de Paul in the amount of \$40,000.
