WHEREAS, Lane County, in partnership with other governments, purchased a telephone system in 1986;

WHEREAS, The telephone system's useful life was estimated at eight years;


WHEREAS, the telephone system, in its tenth year, has reliability problems that impact the ability of County Departments to provide adequate customer service:

WHEREAS, Lane County adopted a telephone plan in 1994 that directed Lane Council of Governments to plan for a system replacement, including an equipment reserve;


WHEREAS, Lane County and the other partners desire to improve telephone system reliability and service to Lane County citizens;

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW HEREBY ORDERED, that Lane Council of Governments is authorized to replace the telephone system serving the Courthouse and Public Service Building.
