WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has accepted revenues pursuant to the 1995-97 Intergovernmental Agreement #20-001 with the State Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Services Division (MHDDSD); and

WHEREAS, Lane County operates an Alcohol, Drug and Offender (ADO) Program pursuant to the above named agreement; and

WHEREAS, there is a current need to make a staff FTE change, and to accommodate the need for the use of temporary help; and

WHEREAS, PAAF #9 from MHDDSD provides adequate funding to accomplish the above; now therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners increase A .75 FTE Alcohol, Drug and Offender (ADO) Program Manager position to a 1.0 FTE position; approve a fund transfer for the manager position; and to allow the hiring of temporary help in the ADO Program in the Department of Health and Human Services.
