
WHEREAS, the City/County Insurance Services Trust (CIS), which is sponsored by the League of Oregon Cities and the Association of Oregon counties as a service to Oregon cities and counties, offers pooled self-insurance offering cost stability and the potential for long-term savings; and

WHEREAS, membership in CIS is of benefit in managing the risks involved in providing services; and

WHEREAS, the Bylaws of the CIS Trust require that the governing body of the County agree by resolution or contract to become a member of the CIS Trust; now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Lane County does hereby enter into a contract with CIS to become a member of the CIS Trust for General Liability and Automobile Liability for activities relating to or arising out of the Intergovernmental Narcotics Enforcement Team for a three-year period commencing July 1, 1995, and shall abide by the terms of the Trust Agreement, By Laws, and Rules of CIS which, along with this Order, constitutes the contract between Lane County and CIS. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to execute such documents as are necessary pursuant to this Order.
