CHILDREN AND FAMILIES FOR \$22,500 AND APPROPRIATING  
FUNDS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

WHEREAS, the community of Cottage Grove has completed a plan to develop a youth peer court to divert first time juvenile misdemeanor and Class C felony offenders from the formal juvenile justice system, and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Commission on Children and Families has been awarded a Title V Delinquency Prevention Grant for \$22,500 to help fund the South Lane Peer Court, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners as the governing body of Lane County may, in accordance with ORS 294.326(2), appropriate by resolution unanticipated revenues and expenditures,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that within Fund 24 for FY 95-96:

- (1) Lane County accept a \$22,500 grant from the Oregon Commission on Children and Families to fund the South Lane Peer Court, and
- (2) additional revenue and expense in the amount of \$22,500 be appropriated in the Department of Children and Families (12) in FY 1995/96.
