) WITH NO FUNDING TO BE PROVIDED BY
) SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE
) CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS, GUTTER AND
) SIDEWALKS ON THE ROADS TO SERVE THE
) LANE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Lane County Fairgrounds serves the general public; and

WHEREAS, the existing road system currently does not adequately serve the Lane County Fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS, a plan has been developed for construction of roads that will provide better service and access to the Lane County Fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the construction of Roads to Serve the Lane County Fairgrounds will include curbs, gutters, and sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, Lane Code, Section 15.636(2)(a) states that the costs of constructing curbs, gutters and sidewalks within the Urban Service Boundary shall be assessed to the abutting property; and

WHEREAS, According to Lane Code, Section 15.605, the Lane County Board of Commissioners has the power to determine the extent to which the cost of road improvements in Lane County is to be defrayed by special assessments; NOW THEREFORE, BE IT

ORDERED, that the Roads to Serve the Lane County Fairgrounds project be funded by general road fund revenues only, with no funding to be provided by special assessments for the construction of curbs, gutters and sidewalks on the Roads to Serve the Lane County Fairgrounds project.
