WHEREAS, the Eugene-Springfield Metropolitan Area General Plan mandates that City of Eugene and Lane County develop a River Road - Santa Clara Service Plan; and

WHEREAS, Lane County is committed, under a 1980 agreement with the State Environmental Quality Commission to develop and adopt a matter sewerage plan for the River Road - Santa Clara area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners by a Joint Resolution 83-4-27-22 authorized a joint study to resolve issues relative to the provisions of a full range of urban services, including sanitary sewers to the River Road - Santa Clara area; and

WHEREAS, the River Road - Santa Clara Citizens Advisory Team has issued the River Road/Santa Clara Urban Facilities Plan, Sanitary Sewer Service Element (Report); and

WHEREAS, the Report is one component of the Urban Service Plan for River Road - Santa Clara and functions to implement the mandates of the Metropolitan Area General Plan and support an application for federal construction grant funds to build interceptor sewers in River Road - Santa Clara; and

WHEREAS, the Report studies the development of wastewater transport and treatment alternatives, compares feasible alternatives based on their capital, operational and maintenance costs, considers the environmental impacts of the alternatives, develops an implementation plan and considers financing alternatives for the recommended alternative; and

WHEREAS, one of the principal findings and recommendations of the report is that provision of sanitary sewer service to the area is necessary and that the construction of Alternative 3A or 3B is the preferred technical alternative for providing that service. This conclusion is supported by the findings and recommendations set out in Chapter 10 of the Report; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approved Order #83-4-27-23 authorizing the City of Eugene to obtain Federal (EPA) grants for sewer systems for the River Road - Santa Clara area; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received from the Lane County Planning Commission a recommendation to approve the Report; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners conducted public hearings and approved Order 84-6-6-30 on June 12, 1984, adopting the River Road/Santa Clara Urban Facilities Plan - Sanitary Sewer Service Element; and

WHEREAS, based upon the above recommendation and the evidence and testimony already in the record as well as the evidence and testimony adduced at the public hearing held in the matter of amending the Metropolitan Plan,

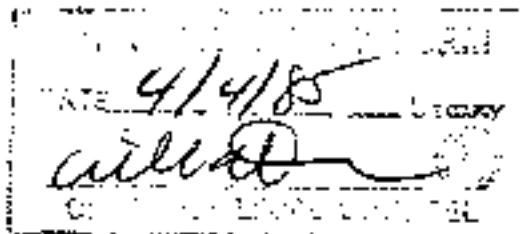
NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County Ordains as Follows:


1. The Eugene-Springfield Metropolitan Area General Plan is amended to include the recommendations of the River Road/Santa Clara Urban Facilities Plan - Sanitary Sewer Service Element as described in the attached Exhibit "A".
2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.


