

12 Ways You Can Support A Girl

1. Pay membership dues for a girl to join an organization that provides after-school activities such as the *Eugene Family YMCA* and the *Boys & Girls Club of Emerald Valley*.
2. Mentor a girl! Check out *Committed Partners for Youth* or other non-profits with girls' programs.
3. Notice when a girl is smart and capable and tell her.
4. Volunteer at a *school-based or community health center*.
5. Get your company involved in *Junior Achievement* to help teach girls about financial literacy.
6. Encourage a girl to participate in the local *4-H club*, *Ophelia's Place* or *ACT-SO* to learn important leadership and life skills.
7. Hire a girl, teach her what you know and celebrate her achievements.
8. Sponsor a scholarship for a girl to pursue her interest in art, dance, music or sports.
9. Buy a girl-appropriate book or a subscription for a healthy girls' magazine—such as *New Moon*—for your school or library.
10. Promote a girls' discussion group through your civic organization or faith community.
11. Donate to an organization that serves girls in crisis such as *WomenSpace*, *Looking Glass* or *Planned Parenthood*.
