Individually, board members address the needs of constituents and carry out special assignments as the full Board may direct. This program includes Performance Auditing, which provides the Board with independent management audits of selected programs within Lane County government.

Occupational Background: Oregon State Senator, State Representative, logger, truck driver, carpenter, house painter, labor union representative, appraiser, licensed building contractor

Education: Lane Community College

Prior Elected Office and Committee Work:

During his legislative career, Dwyer was nominated three times by both Republican and Democratic Parties.

Oregon House of Representatives - Three terms, elected in 1986, 1988, and 1990. Played a key role in Oregon's historic ban on log exports from state lands - protecting timber industry family jobs. Served on committees including House Water Policy Committee (chair); Sunset Review Committee (chair); Agriculture, Forestry & Natural Resource Committee; Labor Committee; Intergovernmental Affairs Committee; Children's Care Team

Oregon Senate - Appointed 1991, elected 1992, reelected 1994. Served on such committees as: Business Housing and Consumer Affairs Committee (chair); Water Policy Committee (chair); Ways and Means Committee (including Subcommittee No. 1, Subcommittee on Education, Subcommittee on General Government, Subcommittee on Natural Resources/Transportation. Subcommittee on Public Safety/Education); and Joint Committee on Data Processing

Prior Public Service: Has consecutively been in public office for 17 years. Assistant to Lane County Board of Commissioners, Lane County Board of Equalization, Governor's Task Force on Disability Services, Oregon Commission for Women, Pacific NW Economic Region Compact

Community Service: Past Family Counseling Service board member, past Lane County Labor Council delegate
