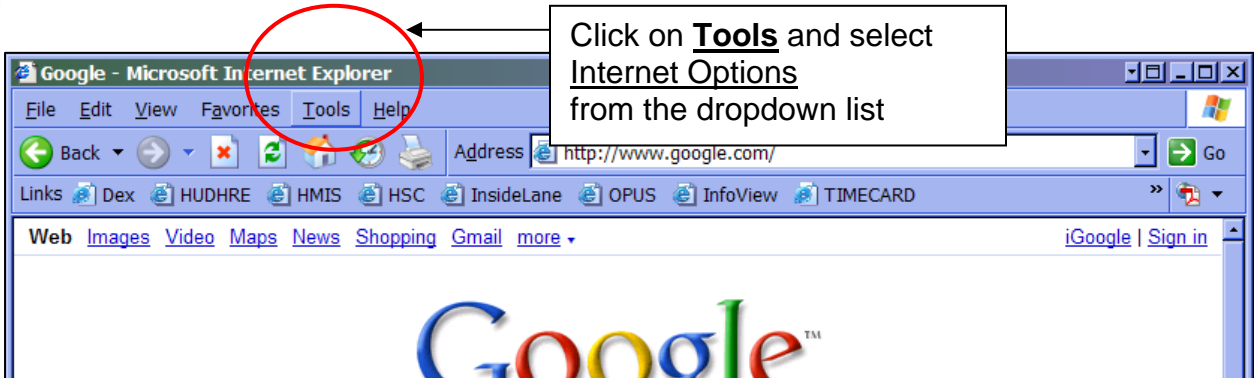


# How to Set Up Your Computer to Print OPUS Reports

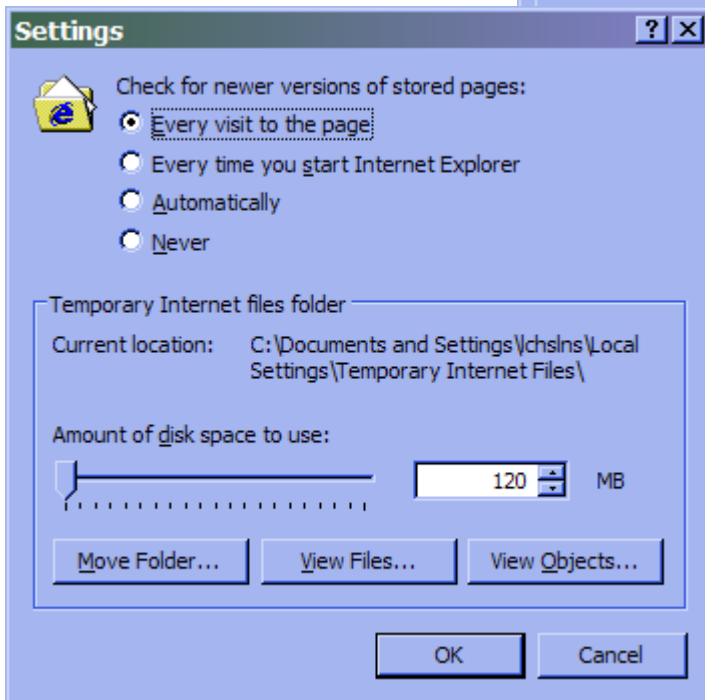
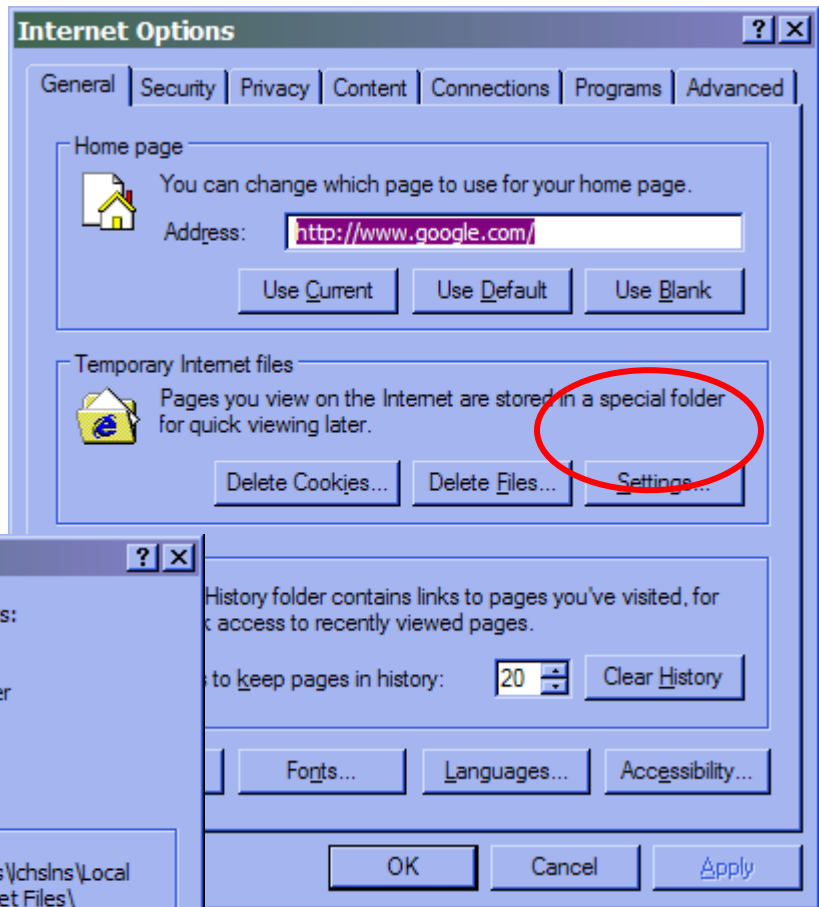


## STEP 1:

Open your Internet Explorer browser. Be sure to use Internet Explorer and not other browsers such as Safari. There are functions in OPUS that work only in Internet Explorer.



STEP 2: On the **General** tab: Click the **Settings** button in the Temporary Internet files section.



STEP 3: Click the radio button next to "Every visit to the page" then click **OK**.

STEP 4: On the **Advanced** tab:  
Check the box under Java (Sun).

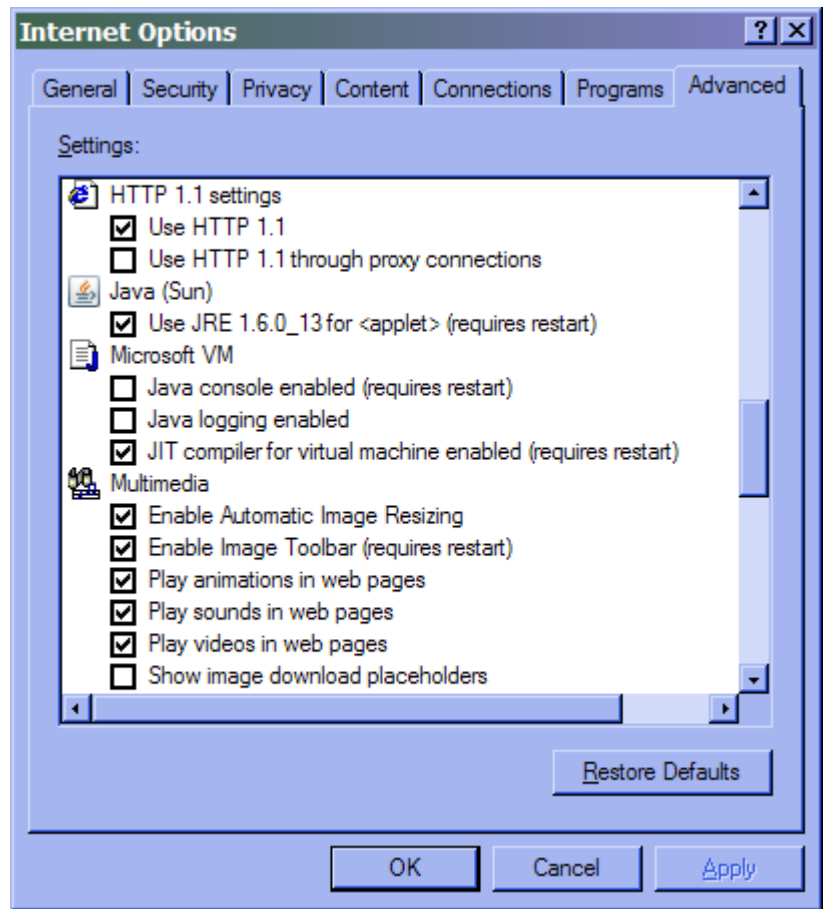
Click **OK**.

Close your browser.

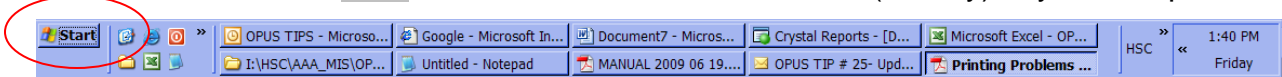
Troubleshooting:

If Java (Sun) isn't displayed in your list,  
you will need to install Java (Sun) from  
<http://java.com> .

When downloading there will be two  
security certificates. Check "always" on  
both certificates.



STEP 5: Click on the **Start** button on the bottom left corner (usually) of your computer monitor.

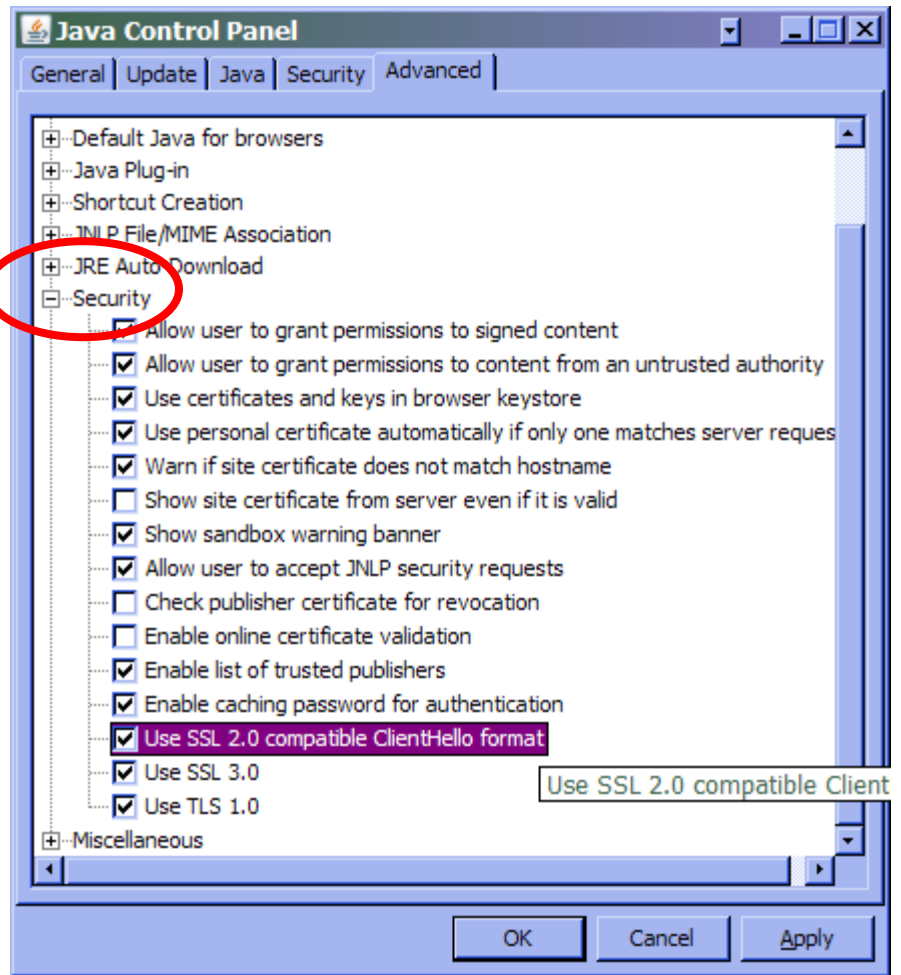


Click on Settings and select Control Panel.  
Double click on the Java icon.

STEP 6: On the Advanced tab:  
Click the plus sign next to Security  
to view all options.

Be sure that the box for “Use SSL  
2.0 compatible ClientHello format”  
is checked.

Click **OK**.



The next time you run a report in OPUS you will get a pop-up. Check the box to always trust  
content from this publisher and click the Run button.

This program will install  
and allow you to print.
