Moisture Content Verification

Oregon Residential Specialty Code, Section R109.1.4.1 Moisture Content states:

After the framing inspection and prior to the installation of interior finishes, the building official shall be notified in writing by the general contractor that all moisture-sensitive wood framing members used in construction have a moisture content of not more than 19 percent of the weight of dry wood framing members.

Item 1191 "BLDG-GC Moisture Content Test" has been added to the inspection list for your project to ensure this requirement is satisfied. This inspection item will not be approved until this Moisture Content Verification form has been completed and submitted to the Building Inspector for your project. Subsequent inspections cannot be scheduled or approved until this item is complete. Whenever possible, it is preferred that this form be completed and ready for submittal at the time of framing inspection (Item 1190) and that both inspections be requested and approved at the same time.

By signing below, I certify that all moisture-sensitive wood framing members used in the construction of the above referenced project for the scope of work covered by the above referenced permit number have a moisture content of not more than 19 percent of the weight of dry wood framing members in accordance with R109.1.4.1 of the Oregon Residential Specialty Code. I further attest to the fact that I am either an authorized agent of the General Contractor for the project or am the owner of the property on which the project is being built and am acting as my own general contractor.
