 - (a) An application is submitted pursuant to Type II application requirements of LC Chapter 14. (b) The application is reviewed pursuant to Type II procedures of LC Chapter 14.
 - (c) The application complies with the criteria of LC 16.256(2) below.

(a) Exceptional or extraordinary circumstances apply to the property which do not apply
generally to other properties in the same zone or vicinity which result from lot size or shape
topography or other circumstances over which the property owner, since the enactment of thi chapter, has had no control.
