## Technology Program

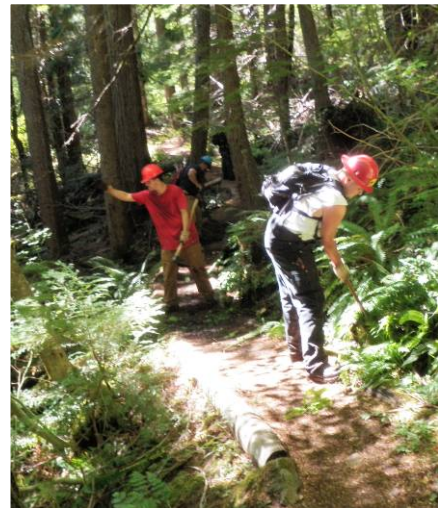
