) ON PAROLE OR PROBATION.

WHEREAS, the federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT) has released a request for grant proposals to enhance substance abuse treatment capacity in local communities with serious, emerging drug problems; and

WHEREAS, Lane County Parole and Probation officer caseloads are very large which limits their ability to provide adequate supervision and timely and effective referral to treatment and services; and

WHEREAS, a caseload of clients who repeatedly violate conditions of supervision by engaging in alcohol and/or other drug use are continually cycling in and out of failed chemical addiction treatment attempts and the criminal justice system, increasing the workload of police, courts and the jail; and


WHEREAS, a planning process was conducted and determined that intensive case management with appropriate treatment and other service enhancements for this corrections client population may be more effective; and

WHEREAS, a proposal, including funds to support local administration of the grant, has been developed and must be forwarded to CSAT for review and possible award.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the county administrator to sign the CSAT grant application for up to \$500,000, each year, for three years, to support individuals who have unmet alcohol/drug treatment needs.
