RESOLUTION) IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
AND ORDER:) ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE
03-1-15-10) FEDERAL DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE ON VIOLENCE
AGAINST WOMEN (OVW), FOR UP TO \$250,000 PER YEAR FOR A
TWO YEAR PERIOD TO ENHANCE SERVICES AND RESPONSE TO
125 ADULT DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OFFENDERS.

WHEREAS, the federal Department of Justice (DOJ), Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) has released a request for grant proposals to encourage arrest policies and enforcement of protection orders; and


WHEREAS, Lane County Parole & Probation officer caseloads contains adult domestic violence offenders and the current system limits their ability to provide adequate support and responses to offenders and the defendants; and

WHEREAS, Lane County already participates in a successful collaboration effort, Victim Protection Pilot Project, and this grant proposal is designed to build upon the current system; and

WHEREAS, a proposal, including funds to support local administration of the grant, has been developed and must be forwarded to OVW for review and possible award.


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the county administrator to sign the OVW grant application for up to \$250,000, per year, for two years, to encourage arrest policies and enforcement of protection orders.
