The Board of County Commissioners of Lane County orders as follows:


THIS MATTER having come before the Board of County Commissioners for approval of Amendment No. Two (2) to Pharmaceutical Services Agreement between Lane County and Contract Pharmacy Services, Inc.

WHEREAS, Contract Pharmacy Services, Inc. has a three-year Pharmaceutical Services Agreement with Lane County to provide inmate pharmacy services to Lane County Adult Corrections Facility.


WHEREAS, Lane County has submitted this amendment extending the Inmate Pharmacy Services Agreement an additional seventy-five (75) days, exceeding the signature authority of the County Administrator.

**PHARMACEUTICAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
AMENDMENT 2**

WHEREAS, Contract Pharmacy Services, Inc., a Pennsylvania Corporation hereinafter referred to as CONTRACTOR, and Lane County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, entered into a pharmaceutical services agreement on 17 October 2000 for the purpose of providing inmate pharmacy services to the Lane County Adult Corrections Facility; and

WHEREAS, Amendment 1 to Agreement expires 16 January 2004; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for the continuation of assistance through 31 March 2004, and an increase in the contract amount not to exceed \$60,000.

NOW THEREFORE, the agreement is amended as follows:

1. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree to extension of the agreement until 31 March 2004.
2. The previous requirements contract (PO # 215026) total expense to date is approximately \$917,858; this amendment increases that by \$60,000, bringing the expected contract total to \$977,858.
3. All other provisions of the original contract not altered by this amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
