RESOLUTION AND ORDER: IN THE MATTER OF Ratifying the Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Youth Authority for Wraparound Services in the Amount of \$320,400 and Increasing Appropriations and Expenditures in Youth Services in the Amount of \$37,110.

WHEREAS, Lane County and the Oregon Youth Authority are working collaboratively to reduce delinquency and effectively treat youth in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Youth Authority initiated an Intergovernmental Agreement with Lane County to provide wraparound services to delinquent youth; and

WHEREAS, in order for Lane County to perform its obligations under this agreement, appropriations must be increased; and

WHEREAS, in order to have the Intergovernmental Agreement returned to the state by the required due date and maximize the amount of funds available to Lane County, the county administrator previously signed the agreement; it is hereby


RESOLVED and ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners ratify the previously signed Intergovernmental Agreement from the Oregon Youth Authority; and it is further

ORDERED that appropriations in revenues and expenditures in fund 124 be increased by \$37,110.
