DETAILS: The Lane County Sheriff's Office along with the assistance of the Oregon State Police responded to a call from a vacation home owner in the Florence area involving a suspicious subject and vehicle. A deputy and trooper contacted Arrington in a U-Haul Truck at a residence near the caller's vacation home. Arrington informed the deputy and trooper that much of the property in the U-haul was stolen from vacation type homes in and around Florence. The property included big screen televisions, furniture, boat motors and parts, along with kayaks.

Information developed during the investigation led to the discovery of several properties that had been recently burglarized. A check with U-Haul revealed the truck was 27 days "overdue." U-Haul was contacted and responded to recover their truck. Florence Police responded and assisted with gathering, transporting and storing the alleged stolen property. All the property will be stored in the Florence area. Attempts are underway to identify and return the property to its rightful owners.

To-date one owner has been identified and property is in the process of being returned.

Arrington was lodged at the Florence Justice Center on the above charges, where he will remain until his transport to the Lane County Jail. Arrington had an older German Shepherd-type dog with him at the time of his arrest. The dog is being temporarily sheltered at the Florence Humane Society.
