Executive Summary

The Court Transportation/Security Unit supports the operations of the Lane County Circuit Court. The Transport Unit moves inmates to and from the jail and courthouse for proceedings, coordinates and conducts out of state extraditions, transports inmates to and from correctional and mental health facilities and provides courthouse, Juvenile Justice Center and Public Service Building security.

Deputies assigned to Court Transportation and Court Security are responsible for moving inmates to and from the jail and courthouse for proceedings, moving inmates to and from state prisons and other county correctional facilities, they coordinate and conduct out of state extraditions and transport inmates to and from mental health facilities. These deputies assist jail staff and occasionally conduct medical transports for in custody inmates needing medical attention outside the jail. They additionally provide security for Lane County Circuit Court, the Juvenile Justice Center and the Public Service Building. FTE: 6 Transport Deputies and 1 records Officer. A transfer from the General Fund partners with the Lane County Circuit Court to provide security in the courthouse, Juvenile Justice Center and Public Service Building.
