Executive Summary

Lane County Medical-legal Death Investigators are on track to investigate between 1,500 and 1,800 suspicious and unattended deaths over the next year. Our Lead Medical-legal Death Investigator, and Medical-legal Death Investigators work with law enforcement partners, the State Medical Examiner's pathologist assigned to Lane County and others to investigate and report cause and manner of death. Over five FTE are required to fully cover a 24/7 post, but we currently have four full-time employees, and a handful of part-time staff who agree to accept on-call shifts, to manage 24/7 coverage.

Work with law enforcement partners, the State Medical Examiner's pathologist assigned to Lane County, and others to investigate and report the cause and manner of all unattended and suspicious deaths.
