The County Veteran Services Office (CVSO) assists veterans and their qualifying family members obtain benefits from the Dept. of Veteran Affairs (VA) based on the veteran's military service. The main benefits we obtain for our clients are eligibility for VA health care, service connected compensation (akin to Worker's Comp for the military) and a needs-based pension which often can significantly help veterans and surviving spouses afford long-term care.

Provides counseling, advice and assistance to veterans and their survivors or dependent parents in obtaining the benefits provided for them by state and federal laws. In FY 21-22, the program assisted its clients submit 874 claims for VA benefits and 307 "decision review" requests (similar to an appeal). In that same FY, program clients received 700 VA benefit decisions which resulted in \$4.775 million in one- time retroactive benefits and \$1.264 million in monthly, on-going benefits. FY 23-24 allocation maintains current service level and the County general fund support required to satisfy the maintenance of effort requirement to receive State of Oregon pass-through funding for CVSO's.						
State/Federal Mandate
