

**YOUR STREET WILL BE CLOSED**

From 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM

**Lane County and the City of Springfield** have awarded a contract to Pave Northwest, Inc. of Marcola, OR to apply a slurry seal to your street. Slurry sealing is a preventative maintenance process that will prolong the life of the street by sealing the street surface and providing a new wearing surface.

***Weather permitting; YOUR STREET WILL BE CLOSED from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm*** on the date(s) shown on the attached map. ***TOWING WILL COMMENCE AT 7AM.*** Please **remove all cars, campers, trailers, basketball hoops or other items from the street.** Unfortunately, we will have no choice but to remove any items left on the street at the owner's expense. Only POLICE, FIRE and other EMERGENCY VEHICLES will be permitted to pass through, if necessary, during the closed period.

*When slurry seal is first applied, the material is brown and sticky. After drying, the appearance may still be brown, it may be somewhat coarse and you may see some loose sand for several weeks. This is normal and does not damage the roadway or indicate a problem with the new product.*

To prevent damage to the fresh slurry and to avoid picking material up on tires or shoes, **cars, bikes, people and pets must be kept off** until it is cured, and the street is re-opened, (a period that may be up to 6 hours). In addition, **please refrain from watering your lawn.** Place garbage out as usual.

**In the event the WEATHER forces a cancellation, your street will be RESCHEDULED and you will be RE-NOTIFIED.**

**Please keep in mind that multiple streets are being done on the same day. If you do not see the work crew on your road right at 7:00am, this does not indicate a problem. The colored map on the back of this notice is to be used to help you with parking and avoiding work zones. No traffic will be permitted on the road during the application or curing process. A traffic cone will be placed in every driveway. Once the road work is complete, a clean up crew will come through and remove all debris, masking, no parking signs, cones and barricades from the street. This will indicate that it is safe to use the road and that the road is open to traffic.**
