ORDER NO: 17-03-14-04

IN THE MATTER OF POSTING A 20-TON
WEIGHT LIMIT ON BERNHARDT CREEK ROAD
AT MP 1.8 WHERE A TEMPORARY BRIDGE
HAS BEEN PLACED OVER A ROADWAY
EMBANKMENT FAILURE

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 810.030, the County may impose limits on any weight or dimensions of any vehicle or combination of vehicles to protect any highway or section of highway from being unduly damaged; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the roadway embankment has washed out, narrowing the travel width on a section of Bernhardt Creek Road; and

WHEREAS, County road crews have recently placed a temporary bridge over the embankment failure area to improve the road width and to stabilize the slope until a permanent repair can be designed and constructed; and

WHEREAS, Lane County crews have posted a 20-ton load limit at the temporary bridge site to maintain the embankment stability; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** that the current load posting at the temporary bridge on Bernhardt Creek Road, MP 1.8, remain posted with a 20-ton weight limit for all vehicles.
