DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$5,000,000.00 RESULTING
FROM A GRANT FOR EMERGENCY
RESPONSE FUNCTIONALITY IN HOUSE
BILL 5202 (2002)

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) is administering funding awarded to the Sheriff's Office through House Bill 5202, which was approved in the 2022 Regular Session, for Emergency Response Functionality in the amount of \$5,000,000, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved the grant application and acceptance of the award on July 12, 2022 in order 22-07-12-08, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, per ORS 294.338(2), has authority to appropriate unforeseen specific purpose grant revenue through a Resolution; and

WHEREAS the need, the purpose, and the amount of the grant are herein described;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **RESOLVES** and **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, are increased as follows:
