COMMITTEE OF THREE RESIDENTS TO  
DRAFT AN IMPARTIAL, SIMPLE AND  
UNDERSTANDABLE EXPLANATORY  
STATEMENT FOR THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022  
STATE VOTERS' PAMPHLET REGARDING  
THE QUESTION OF A FIVE-YEAR FUNDING  
LEVY TO SUPPORT THE LANE COUNTY  
PARKS DIVISION

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners will consider placing the question of a five-year funding levy to support the Lane County Parks Division on the November 8, 2022 ballot; and

**WHEREAS**, the November 8, 2022 election is a general election and will include a number of statewide candidates and measures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Secretary of State's Office will publish a voters' pamphlet to distribute to each household in Oregon; and


**WHEREAS**, Lane Code 2.045 establishes that county measures may be included within the state voters' pamphlet and, if so, that an explanatory statement shall be printed; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a \$300.00 charge to include the explanatory statement in the state voters' pamphlet and Lane County shall pay that expense; if the measure passes the amount shall be reimbursed from levy proceeds.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Consistent with Lane Code 2.045, the following people are appointed as the explanatory statement committee:
  - a. Greg James
  - b. Cindy Land
  - c. Robert Warren
2. The committee is directed to write and submit an impartial, simple and understandable explanatory statement of no more than 500 words to address the proposal to establish a five-year funding levy to support Lane County Parks using the final decision of the Board of County Commissioners, anticipated on August 9, 2022.
3. The cost of the explanatory statement printing will be reimbursed to Lane County by the Parks Division from levy proceeds if the measure passes.
