In the Matter of Amending the Contract with  
Robertson/Sherwood/Architects for  
Courthouse Planning and Scoping Work and  
to Study Cost Reduction Strategies, and  
Delegating Authority to the County  
Administrator to Execute the Contract  
Amendment

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has recognized that the current 65-year-old Lane County Courthouse is no longer able to meet the needs of the Lane County community; and

**WHEREAS**, a ballot measure to issue up to \$154 million of general obligations bonds to finance capital costs associated with a new courthouse failed to pass during the May 21, 2019 election; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners will need additional scope and cost analysis, cost reduction options, and additional public input to inform any decisions about the amount and timing of a future potential bond measure for a new Courthouse; and

**WHEREAS**, CoViD-19 interrupted prior efforts for this additional work to proceed, and has changed how many business and court proceedings occur;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. A contract amendment in the amount of \$108,000 to Robertson/Sherwood/Architects, PC for additional services for Courthouse planning and scoping work and to study cost reduction options is approved; and
2. The County Administrator be delegated authority to execute the contract amendment
