In the Matter of Approving Two Public Works Contracts and Amendments and Delegating Authority to the County Administrator to Execute the Approved Contracts and Amendments for Verizon Connect Fleet USA LLC, Expense in the amount of \$300,000; Pape' Trucks, Inc., dba. Pape' Kenworth of Eugene, Expense in the amount of \$530,800.

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual Chapter 20 sets forth the County's policies regarding award, acceptance, and amendment of grants and contracts; and

**WHEREAS**, all of the contracts or grants listed below have been accepted or award in accordance with the requirements of the Lane Manual, including the requirements for competitive selection; and



Implications for policy	No implications; procurement meets all LM20 purchasing policy by way of cooperative purchasing exemption. Specific contract via GSA #47QTCA22D00DD agreement/membership. Sufficient funds have been budgeted for this expense by the General Services Division. This is a net zero expense to General Services as these costs are part of the fleet charge back model to the internal customer base.
Board goals	Telematics provide data and metrics on all county equipment designated as trackable assets. Cellular based devices return location information and operational metrics for Fleet and all other Fleet users to manage their vehicles and equipment efficiently and provides geolocation for operator safety and asset location. Fleet already utilizes this technology and needs to renew its level of service. The service will support the Board's Strategic Priority of and "Robust Infrastructure: to maintain and invest in resilient infrastructure that creates the highest return for safety, community connectivity, enjoyment of life, and local economic success."

Term of agreement	Current date – Ends with successful procurement of equipment procured meeting County's specifications.

Implications for policy	No implications; procurement meets all LM20 purchasing policy by way of cooperative purchasing exemption. Specific contract via Sourcwell agreement/membership # 060920-KTC. Sufficient funds have been budgeted for this procurement by Lane County Public Works Roads Division.
Board goals	These Dump Trucks will provide field service capabilities to improve efficiency of operations in assigned Roads sub-divisions and replace aging equipment. The purchase will support the Board's Strategic Priorities of "Vibrant Communities: Invest in Lane County residents by fostering engaged communities with affordable housing options, equitable opportunities, economic vitality and a healthy environment" and "Robust Infrastructure: to maintain and invest in resilient infrastructure that creates the highest return for safety, community connectivity, enjoyment of life, and local economic success."
