**WHEREAS**, the contract listed below has been accepted or award in accordance with the requirements of the Lane Manual, including the requirements for competitive selection; and


**WHEREAS**, all the projects and services covered by the contract listed below is routine to the implementation of services or have been previously discussed or approved by the Board; and

Description	Bulk Handling Systems will produce 30% design plans for their proposed mixed waste processing facility. These plans will deliver accurate construction and materials costs to provide the Board of County Commissioners in order to make a decision on whether to proceed with the project.
