In the Matter of APPROVING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA FOR A TEN-YEAR SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT FOR REGIONAL RADIO SYSTEM UPGRADES AND SUPPORT AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT

**WHEREAS**, Lane Regional Interoperability Group (LRIG), Southwest Seven (SW7) and Linn-Benton Regional Interoperability Group (LBRIG) together comprise the Regional Radio System; and

**WHEREAS**, these systems have been operating under a Service Level Agreement with Motorola since 2014 which will expire on June 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the continued functionality of these essential systems over both the shortand long-term is dependent upon upgrading and maintenance of the communication systems and the equipment is proprietary to Motorola, making them the sole-source vendor to perform the services; and

WHEREAS, the agency parties to each of these consortiums have agreed to share the costs of the Motorola Solutions, Inc. contract and other costs of the system in a fair manner allocated among the parties and will sign an IGA to document the cost sharing; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual requires approval by the Board of County Commissioners for contracts in excess of \$150,000 or three years in duration;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- **1.** Approve Motorola as the sole-source provider of service, maintenance and upgrades to the systems operating under the Agreement.
- **2.** Approve a ten-year Service Level Agreement in the amount of \$21,545,045 to be shared by the partners in the Regional Radio System.
- **3.** Delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the Agreement.
