ORDER NO: 22-04-11-02

IN THE MATTER OF AWARDING A  
CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF  
\$843,549.00 TO CML SECURITY, LLC TO  
INSTALL NEW SECURITY CAMERAS AND  
VIDEO MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (VMS) AT  
THE LANE COUNTY JAIL, AND  
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE  
COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE  
THE CONTRACT.

**WHEREAS**, the majority of existing security cameras and associated video management system are largely outdated and beyond their useful life; and

**WHEREAS**, a reliable and robust video surveillance system is critical for safe operation of the jail - providing a safe and secure facility for both adults in custody (AIC) and all facility personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding for replacing the security cameras and the video management system is provided under the Capital Improvement fund to be reimbursed by allocated American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department Manager has reviewed and approved this project and its funding source;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The Lane County Adult Corrections Video Surveillance Management System (VSMS) Project is approved for funding and construction.
2. The County Administrator is granted authority to execute all contracts relative to this project.
