ORDER NO. 23-04-25-10

IN THE MATTER OF THE SURRENDER OF  
SOUTH 6TH STREET, COUNTY ROAD NO. 538,  
TO THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE WITH A  
PUBLIC HEARING. (21-03-04-21, 21-03-04-24).

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cottage Grove, pursuant to Resolution 2090, dated February 13, 2023, has requested Lane County surrender jurisdiction of an annexed portion of South 6th Street to the City of Cottage Grove; and

**WHEREAS**, ORS 373.270 provides for the surrender and transfer of jurisdiction over County Roads within a City, the County may transfer jurisdiction over County Roads or parts thereof within a City when it is considered to be necessary, expedient, or in the best interest of the County to do so; and the governing body of the City deems it necessary or expedient and in the best interest of the City to acquire jurisdiction over the County Roads or portions thereof and to the same extent as it has over public streets and alleys of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners approved Order Number 23-03-21-08 setting April 25, 2023 at 1:30 p.m. to conduct a Public Hearing on the matter of the surrender of South 6th Street, as described in Exhibit "A," to the City of Cottage Grove; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners held a Public Hearing on the aforementioned time and date to allow public testimony for consideration, prior to approving or denying these proceedings; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the Public Hearing was posted in six conspicuous places along the road in accordance with procedures outlined in ORS 373.270; and


**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Director of Lane County has favorably recommended that South 6th Street be surrendered to the City of Cottage Grove; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Lane County, in accordance with ORS 373.270, hereby surrenders jurisdiction of South 6th Street, as described in Exhibit "A," to the City of Cottage Grove.

2. This Order shall be filed with the Lane County Clerk in the Commissioner's Journal of Administration and copies forwarded to the Lane County Surveyor and Department of Public Works for updating appropriate indexes and County Road records.

SOUTH 6TH STREET (COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 538)

All that portion of South 6<sup>th</sup> Street (County Road No. 538) beginning at the southerly end of that portion of South 6<sup>th</sup> Street surrendered to the City of Cottage Grove pursuant to Lane County Board of Commissioner's Final Order No. 07-11-7-7; thence in a southerly direction ending at Engineer's Centerline Station L4 50+40.42 P.O.T., said Engineer's Centerline Station being opposite and 30 feet westerly from the intersection of the easterly right of way margin of South 6<sup>th</sup> Street and the southerly right of way margin of Taft Street, all located in the Northeast One-Quarter of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian.
