COUNTY, DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO  
THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO  
EXECUTE THE IGA, DELEGATING  
AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY  
ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN IGA  
WITH THE LANE COUNTY FIRE  
DEFENSE BOARD TO DEFINE AND  
PROVIDE SAID SERVICES

**WHEREAS**, Lane County has been asked by the Lane County Fire Defense Board and the City of Eugene to accept responsibility for managing the Lane County Fire Radio System; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Radio System would be fully funded by Lane County Fire agencies through a Special Revenue Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane County Emergency Management has agreed to provide fiscal administration support for the Special Revenue Fund; and


**WHEREAS**, Lane County Emergency Management would benefit from a closer working relationship with rural Lane County Fire agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the Technology Services Department has the experience and knowledge to manage the Fire Radio System based upon history managing the Lane Radio Interoperability Group (LRIG);

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve the creation of a new Lane County program and service level under the Department of Technology Services for Fire Radio System Management.
2. Approve the IGA between the City of Eugene and Lane County accepting the current radio reserve fund of approximately \$1,500,000.
3. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the IGA with the City of Eugene
4. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to enter into an agreement with the Lane County Fire Defense Board to provide radio system management services.
