In the Matter of APPROVING AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
WITH OREGON DEPARTMENT OF
CORRECTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN A
STATEWIDE AUTOMATED VICTIM
NOTIFICATION SYSTEM AND
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE
COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE
THE IGA

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC), entered into a new software subscription with Information Strategies, Inc. for a statewide automated victim notification system and has the authority to grant non-exclusive, non-transferable sublicenses to local agencies desiring to participate; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Sheriff's Office has historically participated in the notification system and wishes to continue participation into the future; and

WHEREAS, the DOC will provide sublicensing for a period of six years at no cost to the County; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual Chapter 20 requires Board of County Commissioner approval of contracts or IGA's in excess of three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Corrections for participation in a statewide automated victim notification system.
2. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute the IGA.
