In the Matter of APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH OREGON DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN A STATEWIDE AUTOMATED VICTIM NOTIFICATION SYSTEM AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE IGA

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC), entered into a new software subscription with Information Strategies, Inc. for a statewide automated victim notification system and has the authority to grant non-exclusive, non-transferable sublicenses to local agencies desiring to participate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Sheriff's Office has historically participated in the notification system and wishes to continue participation into the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the DOC will provide sublicensing for a period of six years at no cost to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual Chapter 20 requires Board of County Commissioner approval of contracts or IGA's in excess of three years.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- **1.** Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Corrections for participation in a statewide automated victim notification system.
- 2. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute the IGA.
