ORDER NO: 23-10-24-03

IN THE MATTER OF AWARDING A
CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$12,278,500 TO CML SECURITY, LLC TO
PROVIDE GENERAL CONTRACTING AND
CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE
FACILITY AND TECHNOLOGY UPGRADES
PROJECT AT THE LANE COUNTY JAIL,
AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE
COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE
THE CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has identified an immediate need to upgrade security systems, detention equipment and glazing, fire alarm and life safety systems, mechanical systems, and electrical systems throughout the facility; and

WHEREAS, the upgrades are critical for safe operation of the jail - providing a safe and secure facility for adults in custody (AIC), visitors, and all facility personnel; and

WHEREAS, the funding has been awarded under the Capital Improvement fund to be reimbursed by allocated American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds; and


WHEREAS, these funds must be allocated by December 31, 2024 and expended by December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Department Manager has reviewed and approved this project and its funding source; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The Lane County Adult Corrections Facility and Technology Upgrades Project is approved for funding and construction.
2. The County Administrator is granted authority to execute the contract relative to this project.
