In the Matter of ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT WITH AVIAT US, INC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$487,370.00 FOR INSTALLATION OF MICROWAVE LINKS ON THE RADIO NETWORK SYSTEM AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) and the Lane Regional Interoperability Group (LRIG) operate and manage radio sites within Lane County for the purposes of first responder communications; and

**WHEREAS**, the microwave links between these sites are not redundant and are subject to failures causing loss of communications in rural areas; and

**WHEREAS**, LCSO was awarded funding through the State of Oregon House Bill 5202 for the purposes of projects related to the infrastructure and interoperability of the emergency communications systems; and

WHEREAS, pricing from Aviat is on a cooperative purchasing agreement, National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) contract 00318, and does not require a competitive bid process.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- **1.** Approve the contract with Aviat US, Inc in the amount of \$487,370.00.
- **2.** Delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute the contract.
