MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$270,000 FOR
COMMUNICATION SITE UPGRADES
AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO
THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO
EXECUTE THE GRANT AND
ASSOCIATED CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the Lane County Sheriff's Office maintains multiple communication sites where backup power resources are necessary for continued operations in the event of commercial power failure; and


WHEREAS, the US Department of Homeland Security solicits grant applications for funding projects that support their mission for resiliency and Lane County has been awarded grant funding for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approves all grant awards in excess of \$150,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Accepts the grant from the US Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$270,000 for upgrades to Lane County communication sites.
2. Delegates authority to the County Administrator to sign the grant documents and execute associated contracts.
