ORDER NO: 24-02-27-05

In the Matter of ORDER/ ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$400,000 TO DEVELOP A COMMERCIAL FOOD WASTE COMPOSTING PROGRAM AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AND ASSOCIATED CONTRACTS.

WHEREAS, the Lane County Public Works, Waste Management Division has a plan to reduce food waste by expanding composting opportunities for commercial food producers; and


WHEREAS, the US Department of Agriculture solicits grant applications for funding projects that support their mission for commercial food waste reduction and Lane County has been awarded grant funding for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approves all grant awards in excess of \$150,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Accepts the grant from the US Department of Agriculture in the amount of \$400,000 for making commercial food waste composting more accessible throughout Lane County.
2. Delegates authority to the County Administrator to sign the grant documents and execute associated contracts.

Board goals	This Mower will provide large-scale mowing operations to multiple Waste Management sites including the Short Mountain Landfill to improve efficiency of operations for Waste Management. The single machine was designed to perform multiple tasks for a single operator, increase efficiency, and not disturb natural habitats the Division is responsible for ensuring preservation of. The purchase will support the Board's Strategic Priorities of "Vibrant Communities: Invest in Lane County residents by fostering engaged communities with affordable housing options, equitable opportunities, economic vitality and a healthy environment" and "Robust Infrastructure: to maintain and invest in resilient infrastructure that creates the highest return for safety, community connectivity, enjoyment of life, and local economic success."
