In the Matter of APPROVING A 10-YEAR
MAINTENANCE AND WARRANTY
CONTRACT WITH GRAYBAR IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$90,304.80 ON THE CIENA
EQUIPMENT INSTALLED AT VARIOUS
COMMUNICATION SITES AND
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE
COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE
THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved a grant through Oregon House Bill 5202 to make improvements and enhancements to the Emergency Radio Network in Lane County; and

WHEREAS, a project is underway to put redundancy links between multiple Lane County owned and leased communication sites to provide more reliable communications for first responders; and


WHEREAS, Graybar is a distributor for Ciena products and will facilitate a 10-year, 24/7 maintenance and warranty on the equipment being installed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approves all contracts in excess of three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve a 10-year maintenance and warranty contract with Graybar in the amount of \$90,304.80 for the Ciena equipment being installed at multiple communication sites in Lane County.
2. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute the contract.
