IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING THE
CONTRACT WITH TRINITY FOOD
SERVICES TO UPDATE PRICING AND
EXTEND THE TERM AND DELEGATING
AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY
ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE
AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the Lane County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) operates a Correctional Facility and has a contract with Trinity Food Services to provide meals and laundry services to the Adults in Custody (AIC); and

WHEREAS, Trinity is having difficulty maintaining staff with their current wage allowances and the contract with LCSO expires on October 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, LCSO needs ample time to complete a Request for Proposal (RFP) process to solicit bids from providers for food and laundry services in the Correctional Facility; and


WHEREAS, Trinity is offering a favorable CPI increase to the current contract to allow them to address their salaries and to extend the contract through the end of FY 2025, which will allow LCSO time to post an RFP; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approves all contracts in excess of \$150,000 and three years in length.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve the updated pricing for Trinity Food Services and extend the contract until June 30, 2025.
2. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute the amendment.
