AGENDA ITEM TITLE: ORDER / In the Matter of Re-appointing One Member (Lisa Arkin) to the Lane County Planning Commission

#### I. MOTION

MOVE TO RE-APPOINT ONE MEMBER TO THE LANE COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION.

### II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

There is a need to re-appoint one member to serve on the Lane County Planning Commission (LCPC) due to term expiration for Lisa Arkin.

### III. DISCUSSION

### A. Background

Lane Code and Lane Manual provide that the Planning Commission shall be established and that the Lane County Planning Commission shall consist of nine voting members to perform the duties and functions of the Planning Commission. Also, at least one member shall be from the coastal area of Lane County, and another must be a resident or own property on the coast. The current position on the Lane County Planning Commission expired in 2008 and staff inadvertently missed preparing an order for Ms. Arkin's re-appointment.

### B. Analysis

County Administration advertised the vacancy in August and September 2011. Applications were reviewed and Commissioner Sorenson requests the Board re-appoint Lisa Arkin for the remaining year of her second term as a representative for District 3.

Lane Manual and the ORS require that no more than two members of the Planning Commission be engaged in the buying, selling, or developing of real estate for profit as individuals, or be members of any partnership or officers or employees of any corporation that is engaged principally in the buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit. Also, no more than two voting members of the Planning Commission shall be engaged in the same kind of occupation.

Lane Manual requires the Lane County Planning Commission to consist of nine voting members, each of whom shall be a resident of Lane County, and at least three of the voting members shall reside outside cities and at least two shall reside within cities.

The Board has decided that each Board member appoint a member of the Planning Commission from their district and the four remaining positions are at-large. Commissioner Sorenson requests the Board re-appoint Lisa Arkin (administrator/Oregon Toxics Alliance) for the remaining year of her second term on the Lane County Planning Commission as a representative for District 3.

The present planning commission with the proposed appointment would meet the Lane Manual geographic and occupational requirements.

### C. Alternatives/Options

- 1. Accept the recommendations to re-appoint Lisa Arkin from Commissioner District 3 for the completion of her second term on the LCPC.
- 2. Appoint another applicant for this position
- 3. Re-advertise and reopen the search for the vacancy
- 4. Do not re-appoint Lisa Arkin to the Lane County Planning Commission

### D. Recommendations

Staff will follow-up on the Board's recommendation, immediately. Appointment and thank you letters are not included with this packet. The letters will follow pending the Board's decision.
