I. MOTION

IT IS MOVED THAT THE ORDER/RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED APPROVING THE OPERATING BUDGET AND THE OPERATING FUND CALCULATION OF OPERATING SUBSIDY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2004.

II. ISSUE

HUD requires the Board to review and approve the Public Housing Program Operating Budget and the Calculation of Operating Subsidy.

III. DISCUSSION

A. Background

This Order/Resolution approves our FY2004 budget and calculation of operating subsidy for the Public Housing Program. In previous years, this resolution/order was submitted to the Board late in June so that the approval could be forwarded to HUD prior to their due date of June 30th. HUD issued a notice in January 2003, that changed the due date of our FY2004 budget to May 1st.

B. Analysis

Attached is the Public Housing Program Operating Budget (HUD Form 52564) and Operating Fund Calculation of Operating Subsidy (HUD Form 52723) for FY2004. A summary of the Operating Budget follows.
