I. MOTION

ORDER/IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE LANE WORKFORCE PARTNERSHIP BOARD OF DIRECTORS

II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

The Workforce Investment Act of 1998 requires the establishment of local workforce investment boards (comprised of a majority from business). The local board sets policy for the workforce investment system in its area.

III. DISCUSSION

A. Background

The Lane Workforce Partnership is the local workforce investment board for Lane County under the Workforce Investment Act. In order to receive federal job training funds for youth, adults and dislocated workers, workforce boards must include representation from the following groups:

- 1. Business must be owners of businesses, chief executives or operating officers of business, and other business executive or employers with optimum policymaking or hiring authority.
- 2. Local educational entities
- 3. Labor organizations
- 4. Community-based organizations
- 5. Economic development agencies
- 6. Representatives from each of the one-stop partners

B. Analysis

Michael Carmickle, with Plumber and Steamfitters Local #290, filled a labor representative position on the Lane Workforce Partnership board of directors. Recently, Mr. Carmickle retired from Plumbers & Steamfitters Local #290. The Lane Workforce Partnership received a letter from the Lane Coos Curry Douglas Building Trades Union requesting to replace Mr. Carmickle with Doug McClaughry. Mr. McClaughry is the business representative for Sheet Metal Workers International Association Local #16, and a Training Coordinator for the apprenticeship program. The Lane Workforce Partnership board of directors considers Mr. McClaughry's position on the board an important link in connecting workers with apprenticeship programs.

C. Alternatives/Options

Find another labor representative to fill the vacancy left by Mr. Carmickle.

D. Recommendations

To appoint Mr. McClaughry to the Lane Workforce Partnership board of directors for a three-year term beginning May 1, 2003 through December 31, 2005.

E. Timing

The appointment would be effective the date of signature of the board order.

IV. IMPLEMENTATION

Appointment of would become effective upon approval by the Lane County Commissioners through December 31, 2005.
