I. MOTION

ORDER/IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE LANE WORKFORCE PARTNERSHIP BOARD OF DIRECTORS

II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

The Workforce Investment Act of 1998 requires the establishment of local workforce investment boards (comprised of a majority from business). The local board sets policy for the workforce investment system in that area. In order to receive federal job training funds for youth, adults and dislocated workers, workforce boards must include representation of six groups.

III. DISCUSSION

A. Background

Local boards must include members from the following groups:

- 1. Business must be owners of businesses, chief executives or operating officers of business, and other business executive or employers with optimum policymaking or hiring authority.
- 2. Local educational entities
- 3. Labor organizations
- 4. Community-based organizations
- 5. Economic development agencies
- 6. One-stop partners

B. Analysis

Dan Bedore, Human Resources Director, Country Coach Inc., filled a Lane County business representative position on the Lane Workforce Partnership board of directors. Recently, Mr. Bedore resigned from the board of directors. The Board has recruited Marilou Heriot to fill the vacancy left by Mr. Bedore. Ms. Hariot is the Human Resources Manager for Jerry's Home Improvement Center. She manages the entire human resource function for 324 employees. Ms. Heriot has been nominated by the Eugene Chamber of Commerce. The Lane Workforce Partnership board of directors is requesting that Ms. Heriot be appointed to the Workforce Partnership board as a Lane County business representative.

C. Alternatives/Options

To not appoint Ms. Heriot would result in non-compliance with the Workforce Investment Act and potentially decertification of the Lane Workforce Partnership as the local Workforce Investment Board which would result in loss of services to Lane County residents and businesses.

D. Recommendations

To appoint the Marilou Heriot to the Lane Workforce Partnership board of directors for a three year term beginning January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2005.

E. Timing

The appointment would be effective the date of signature of the board order.

IV. IMPLEMENTATION

Appointment would become effective upon approval by the Lane County Board of Commissioners.
