## I. MOTION

TO DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH EMERALD PEOPLE'S UTILITY DISTRICT (EPUD) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE REACH AND ERAP PROGRAMS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$27,500.

#### II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

A revenue contract amendment with EPUD for funding the REACH and ERAP programs exceeds the county administrator's signature authority.

### III. DISCUSSION

## A. Background / Analysis

The Lane County Human Services Commission (HSC) provides services to low-income customers of local utilities. These local utilities provide funding to the HSC so their customers can participate in these programs. Emerald People's Utility District (EPUD) provides funding to the HSC to serve EPUD low-income customers with the REACH and ERAP programs.

The HSC is amending the current revenue agreement with EPUD currently dated January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, in order to provide additional REACH and ERAP services to EPUD customers and extend the term of the contract through December 31, 2003. This amendment will increase the contract total from \$27,500 to a new total of \$55,000. This amount exceeds the County Administrator's authority.

## B. Alternatives/Options

- 1. To grant authority to the county administrator to sign a contract amendment with EPUD to provide funding in the amount of \$27,500 for the REACH and ERAP programs.
- 2. Not to approve number one above. If the Board of Commissioners does not give the county administrator authority to sign the contract amendment then the county will not accept the funding from EPUD and REACH and ERAP services will not be provided by HSC to EPUD's low-income customers.

## C. Recommendation

To approve number one above.

### IV. IMPLEMENTATION / TIMING

Upon Board action, the Department of Health & Human Services will process the contract amendment.
