ISSUE OR PROBLEM:

Shall each Lane County Commissioner delegate one representative

to sit on the Service Stabilization Task Force and shall the full Board

vote to select four (4) at-large representatives?

DISCUSSION:

A. Background:

The Board of Commissioners established a Service Stabilization Task Force under Board Order 04-6-30-5. Under the previous

order, the Board opened a 30-day recruitment period for four (4) at-

large positions and provided each commissioner with one

appointment for a total of nine (9) positions. The recruitment period

ended on July 30, 2004.

B. Analysis

At this time, each Board member needs to forward a representative for the Stabilization Task Force and the full Board needs to vote for four at-large positions from the pool of candidates who applied.

C. Alternatives/Options

- 1. Approve the order as presented
- 2. Delay action until a future date
- 3. Extend the recruitment process

D. <u>Implications</u>

The completion of the recruitment and selection process for the Stabilization Task Force is needed to meet the criteria set forth in Board Order 04-6-30-5, which sets a deadline for completion of the report by the end of October. Additionally, the first meeting of the Task Force is set for August 10, 2004.

- F. <u>Timing</u> A decision to delay selection may affect the ability of the Service

Stabilization Task Force to complete its work in a timely manner consistent with previous a Board Order.
